**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, REJECTING ALL BIDS
RECEIVED ON AIR GAP/BREAK TANK SYSTEM
PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Gig Harbor recently invited bids on the Air Gap/Break Tank System Project located at the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant and using the City's Small Public Works Bidding process through the MRSC roster; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2020, the City received three responsive bids; and

WHEREAS, all three bidders were unable to comply with the requirements necessary to proceed with the contract work due to irregularities in their bids; and

WHEREAS, the City will be rejecting all bids for the Air Gap/Break Tank System project and hopes to re-bid this work in the first quarter of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City wants to reject all bids in accordance with the City's reservation of right to reject any or all bids as set forth in its Invitation to Bidders and as authorized by RCW 39.26.160; Now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Rejection of Bids. All bids received by the City of Gig Harbor on the Air Gap/Break Tank System Project are hereby rejected.
